This letter is in final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of January 2, 2012, pertaining to the Public Health Assessment for George Air Force Base in Victorville, California.

As a result of a second search of agency records, enclosed please find a compact disc containing 91 pages. Because some shading on the maps is not discernible on the electronic copy, we are also enclosing a hard copy free of charge.

You also requested an index to all records reviewed to produce the PHA. A second search of our records failed to reveal any documents pertaining to your request beyond the "References" section of the health assessment, which is provided as described above.

While we believe that an adequate search of appropriate files was conducted for the records you requested, you have the right to appeal this determination that no records exist which would be responsive to your request.
