BRIEF CLINICAL HISTORY (Include duration of lesion and rapidity of growth, if a neoplasm)

Generalized lymphadenopathy with weight loss past 4 mo. **Three previous episodes of lymphadenopathy with recovery and re-exacerbation.** Past lymph node biopsy showed increased **histiocytosis.** Workup negative for Rheumatology and thyroid screen.

(Gross description, histologic examination and diagnoses)

DIAGNOSIS:

1. **Mildly hypocellular marrow** without significant abnormality
2. Peripheral blood -- **mild neutropenia and ovalocytosis.**

ASSESSMENT:

The cause of the mild neutropenia is not evident from this study other than as a result, perhaps, of his hypocellularity.

PARTICLE AND BIOPSY SECTIONS:

Two-thirds of the biopsy is bone and cartilage, but the remaining third shows 10 to 20% cellularity with an M/E ratio of 3 and adequate megakaryocytes. No tumor or granulomas are noted. The iron stores are adequate.

PARTICLE SMEARS AND IMPRINTS:

The M/E ratio averages 3 with essentially normal maturation of cell lines. No ringed sideroblasts are noted.

PERIPHERAL BLOOD:

The red cells vary mildly in size with occasional oval forms. The 4,000 WBCs show a mild decrease in neutrophils but no blasts. The platelets are normal in number but occasionally enlarged.

GROSS:

The pale core is 1.5 cm long and 0.2 cm thick. (MJ)
